

We are pleased to announce the 12th International Conservation Conference in the series *Problems of Museums Related to the Preservation and Conservation of Collections*. The event will provide a platform for the exchange of knowledge, experience, and best practices in the field of the protection and conservation of museum collections, with particular emphasis on objects of diverse material composition, function, and scale. The Conference programme will comprise the following themes:

1. Preventive conservation and storage of museum collections.
2. Conservation of objects made of organic and inorganic materials, on display outdoors.
3. Conservation of objects intended for operation and large-scale objects.
4. New technologies in the service of museum collections.
5. Operation of historic objects of engineering heritage.

Conference proceedings will include the submitted papers and communications.

The fee of PLN 1,000 includes accommodation for two nights (7/8 October 2026 and 8/9 October 2026) in double rooms with board at the Delicjusz Hotel in Trzebaw, as well as a conference package. In the case of arranging accommodation independently, the conference fee is PLN 700. A study visit is planned on the second day of the event.
